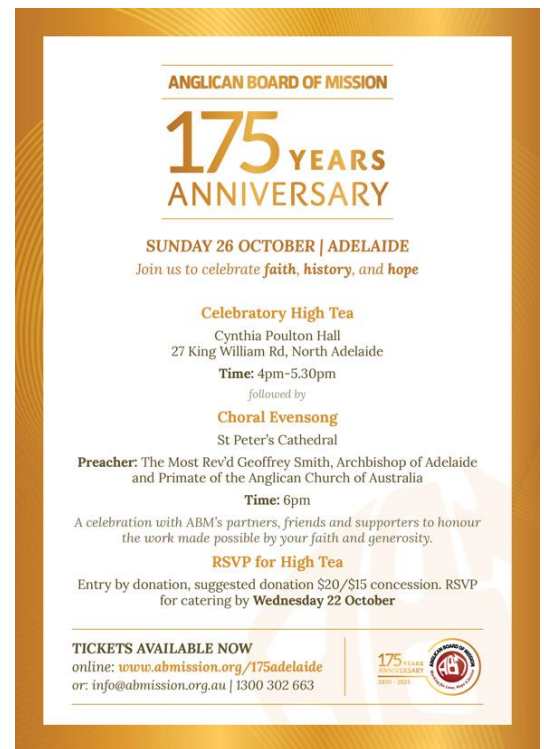
### Brighton Dunes Concert
