Lenten studies are coming, dates and times to be confirmed.


Shrove Tuesday Pancake Night – All Welcome!

Upcoming Courses

- **Adelaide Anglicans Mental Health First Aid**

This 2-day practical short course is for all interested clergy, licensed lay ministers and leaders. The course costs \$180 + BF, payable on registration. For more information and to book click [HERE](#). Places are limited.

Some staff at Adelaide Anglicans have completed the MHFA course and have found their new skills and knowledge to be invaluable for supporting some of our vulnerable community members. This course is recommended for all leaders in our diocese and will be held again later this year to meet demand.

- **Parish Council Governance Workshop – 8 February at St Jude's Brighton**

This workshop is for all members of parish councils in the Anglican Diocese of Adelaide. It is suitable for all parish officers, councillors and clergy, whether new to the role, or more experienced.

The workshop offers an overview of governance generally and in our diocese. Participants will learn about the roles and responsibilities of parish council, why mission is important, how meetings are run, how to make decisions by achieving consensus, and where to go for help. The workshop includes practical activities, discussion, reflection and question time.

- **Archbishop's Certificate Module 8 - Being Anglican**
