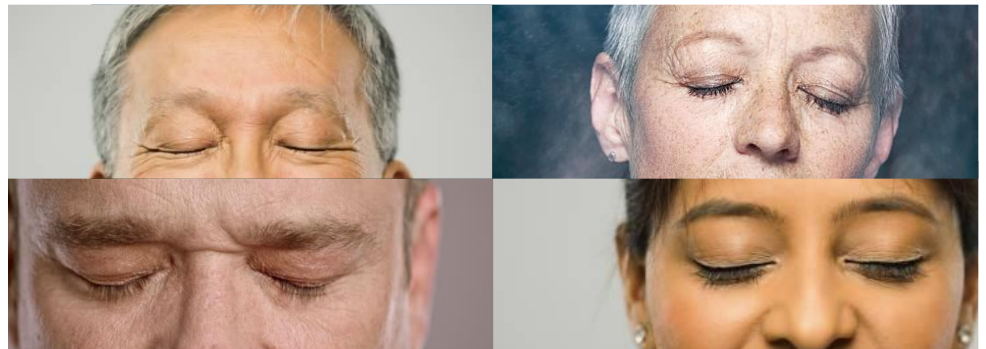


Mothers' Union Film Morning – The Sheep Detectives

The Headstone Project

On Saturday 9 May 2026 at 1pm at St Jude's Cemetery, Brighton, the Headstone Project will be gathering to dedicate the headstone of First World War veteran **Sister Gertrude Giddings**, an Australian Army Nursing Service nurse who served overseas from 1917 to 1919. Born in Norwood, Gertrude endured harsh conditions in Salonika, caring for wounded soldiers through extreme weather, disease, and shortage. She was later promoted to Sister and awarded the British War and Victory Medals. This dedication honours her faithful service and ensures her contribution is remembered: *they served, they deserve to be remembered.*
