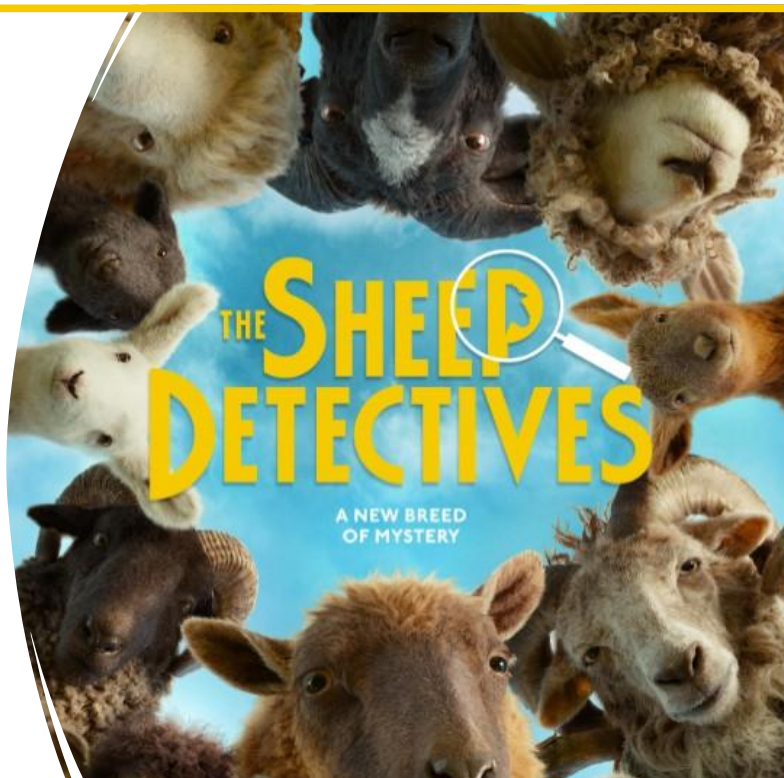
ACVVS Volunteer needed
